Skilled Specialists serve in small crews of AmeriCorps members at a clients' home or construction work site.

## Electric

Skilled Specialists-Electric respond to the Head Electrician and serve on SBP's clients' homes, or jobsites, as assigned including but not limited to the following: Assembling, installing, testing, and maintaining electrical or electronic wiring, equipment, appliances, apparatus, and fixtures, using hand tools and power tools.

## Plumbing

Skilled Specialists-Plumbing respond to the Master Plumber and serve on SBP's clients' homes, or jobsites as assigned including but not limited to the following: Review work orders and prepare material list for completion of jobs, install new plumbing fixtures, assembling pipes

to repair/extend old plumbing lines or add new lines, tracing for leaks, and laying out/install water/drain lines to meet parish/county code.

# Carpentry

Skilled Specialists-Carpentry service on SBP's clients homes, or jobsites, as assigned including but not limited to the following: rough carpentry including reframing and framing; finish carpentry including installing cabinets; hanging exterior doors including bi-folds; installing hardware for doors and closets; creating and maintaining a safe, clean, and neat work environment; and assuring the safe and proper use of tools and equipment.
