### **Position Summary**

The Disaster Corps Manager will lead SBP AmeriCorps Members in disaster response activities and help to establish new construction programs in communities affected by disasters. The Disaster Corps Manager will be responsible for providing ongoing skill development and training to SBP's AmeriCorps members who will execute debris removal, mucking, gutting, mold suppression and immediate repair services to homeowners affected by natural disasters. The Disaster Corps Manager will deploy to multiple disasters throughout the year.

Additionally, the Disaster Corps Manager will support the Disaster Response Operations Director and Chief Recovery Officer in establishing new construction programs, rebuilding storm-affected properties for homeowners affected by disasters.

### **Responsibilities**

- Build and deliver construction skills training and team development across a number of SBP operating sites.
- Deploy to communities affected by disaster to lead SBP's Disaster Corps AmeriCorps member.
- Guide the stand-up of SBP's disaster response program, overseeing the execution of all elements of subcontractor (roof tarping) and team-based construction services (debris removal, mucking, gutting, mold suppression etc.)
- Execute damage-assessments on impacted properties, build scopes of work and material take offs.
- Oversee implementation of SBP's volunteer program in disaster response communities
- Coordinate receiving and distribution of material donations (water, battery packs, cleaning supplies etc.)
- Report daily activities and impact to SBP leadership through established tracking tools.
- In partnership with Disaster Response Operations Director, and Chief Recovery Officer, support start up activities for new SBP construction programs in those communities received response services

## Qualifications

- Ability to deploy to communities affected by disaster, on short notice, for extended deployment
- 3-5 years of residential construction experience.
- 3-5 years of team management and leadership experience.
- Experience supervising team members with diverse skill sets and backgrounds.
- Ability to develop and deliver skill-based training to a wide audiences.
- Clear communication skills and a strong sense of maturity, positivity, and professionalism.
- Able to satisfactorily pass a Criminal History Check to include sex offender registry, State Police, and FBI.
- Valid driver license and reliable transportation.
- Ability to work productively with limited supervision.
- Proven ability to collaborate effectively with a team
- Ability to manage multiple tasks and set priorities in a fast-paced work environment
- Vaccinated against COVID-19 per CDC guidelines and able to provide proof of vaccination.
