Position Summary:

The Logistics Manager will support SBP's Hurricane Dorian recovery efforts by managing, coordinating and overseeing supply and distribution of relief supplies and materials from the US to the Bahamas. This team member will initially focus on relief efforts in Freeport, specifically to Rand Memorial Hospital, and distributing supplies to SBP and Abaco Outreach partners. The position works closely with the NGO Coordinator and reports directly to the Operations Manager. This mission is evolving and growing rapidly, suitable candidates will be comfortable with ambiguity and change.

The ideal candidate will have some or all of the following experience:

- Military or medical and/or health administration
- Logistics, Systems, and/or Supply Chain Management
- Disaster response experience

- Manage supply and logistics activities across from the US to the Bahamas
- Plan and supervise shipments from arrival to receipt
- Distribute supplies to SBP and Abaco Outreach partners
- Build rapport with international and domestic partners
- Ensure premises, assets and communications are used effectively
- Ensure standardized procurement protocols that result in cost and time savings are being followed; while building a culture of cost controls and long term savings through procurement.
- Negotiate solutions to challenges and create value-added opportunities to shrink the time to recovery
